

Attention: Fort Myers Beach Residents

The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) is a federal program which is administered by FEMA through its Federal Insurance Administration. The town of Fort Myers Beach is participating in the flood discount program to promote flood management designed to protect life and property from future flooding. Based on the Town's current rating in the program, residents enjoy a 15% reduction in their current flood insurance premiums. This discount for homeowners is already calculated and deducted in the quote for your premium and will be reflected on your policy. If you have any questions you can contact your current insurance agent for more information. The condo associations will also benefit from this 15% discount in the same way. The flood rebate program which most insurance agents offer is a separate percentage amount that is paid back to the association usually 30-60 days after the flood policy renews. Please check with your insurance provider to see if additional rebate programs apply.
